Day Camp is 9:00-4:00 with early drop off at 8:30am and late pick-up at 5:30 pm.

- PAL will offer 9 weeks of theme based camps during summer for kids ages 8 – 18. The Day Camps will include computer projects, arts & crafts, sports, and games. The Camps are based out of the Beaverton PAL Youth Center features include; a large recreation room with pool tables, air hockey, foosball tables, etc.; IBM Learning Center & Computer Lab, Intel Computer Clubhouse, Art Room, & Kitchen, and the Nike Fitness Gym.
- The Day Camps are lead and supervised by paid PAL staff, program partners (Jesuit High School students, Metropolitan Family Services Foster Grandparent, Beaverton Police Department), and community volunteers. Staff to youth ratio is approximately 1:9
- Each Camp is designed around a specific theme or PAL program. Each week afternoon camp activities include, swimming, playing at the park and fountains, library, and outdoor games. Additional Information is available at PAL.

Registration & Payment:

Cost: \$50.00 per week, and a one-time PAL membership fee of \$50 (or \$30 if family has proof of qualification for free/reduced lunch from schools)

Payment: PAL Accepts Cash, Checks & Visa

When: Pre-registration begins May 12. \$10 Deposit is due at time of registration for each week of camp. Full Payment is due Friday before camp starts or Monday the start of each week (no exceptions).
